Workshop content

The 1-day 'Focus' workshops are designed to help you take your skills to the next level, where ever you are starting from. By focusing on a specific component, we can fully explore that area, increasing understanding and competency which will transfer to your work at home and aid you in creating realistic and vibrant animal art.

Each workshop will include several projects throughout the day and cover colour selection, layering & bending and how to create depth using values.

Tuition will be in small groups and will consist of demos alongside 1-1 help and problem solving as required. Materials are supplied and a take-home guide is included.

Monday 4th March 2019 - Focus on fur textures (equine)

We'll cover manes & tails, looking at how to create fluid and natural looking long hair, plus short and shiny summer coats, shaggy winter coats, and fluffy ears.

Saturday 23rd March 2019 - Focus on eyes (equine)

Discover how to create bright and shiny eyes, with gorgeous reflections. We'll also study the structure of the eye, and a variety of equine expressions.

Saturday 27th April 2019 - Focus on fur textures (dogs)

Black fur, white fur, long, short and curly fur! Lots of variety on this workshop to match our canine friends.

Monday 13th May 2019 - Focus on eyes (big cats)

Discover how to capture the intense stare of the big cats, looking closely at tigers and lions for this workshop.

Monday 17th June 2019 - Focus on fur textures (wildlife)

From the rich russets of the fox to the intense stripes of a tiger, learn to unravel the complexity of these amazing coats.
